

SECTION V: MISCELLANEOUS REGULATIONS

5.1 GENERAL REGULATIONS

5.1.1 No apparatus, equipment or tools may be removed from the station for non-company related business without the approval of a line officer. The Chief shall be notified if available.

5.1.2 No one other than qualified drivers shall start, operate or move any apparatus except during training evaluations. There is no "emergency driver" status.

5.1.3 Firearms are not permitted in the firehouse or on fire company property. Police officers are exempt from this rule.

5.1.4 No fire reports are to be taken from the station or loaned out. Only the Chief or officer in charge of the incident may remove fire reports from the station.

5.1.5 A copy of all insurance, damage and equipment loss reports are to be retained for company records.

5.2 RESPONSE TO AND CREDIT FOR ATTENDANCE AT ALARMS

5.2.1 All personnel shall respond to the station upon receipt of an alarm unless authorized otherwise by the Chief. Those authorized to respond directly to the scene shall carry their company issued turnout gear with them.

5.2.2 Credit for attendance at alarm will be given to all members who respond subject to the restrictions outlined herein. Credit shall also be given to those attending fire school or those involved in other official fire company business at the time of an alarm.

5.2.3 Credit shall not be given for those who:

- a. respond directly to the scene without proper turnout gear
- b. leave the scene of an incident without prior authority by the officer-in-command
